***Architectural Review**: Reviews/approves plans and specifications for structures and landscapes and enforces design guidelines. *Meet 2nd and 4th Mondays each month.*

***Communications**: Alerts community about current events, concerns and civic issues; solicits articles for and publishes the Landfall Voice newsletter. *Meet as needed.*

***Buildings & Grounds**: Works on special projects under the direction of the Landfall COA Board of Directors. *Meet as needed.*

***Covenants & Security**: Responsible for enforcing the Covenants and the Rules & Regulations of Landfall. *Meet the 1st Wednesday each month.*

***Nominating**: Seeks to fill COA committee vacancies and assists with recommendations to fill Council seats. *Meet as needed.*
